



Starting a New Collection?

Perhaps a dozen times in the last 30 years I have gotten a wild bug and began a new collection. There is just so far that one can go collecting a twenty-three year period of red stamps.

One time, this wild bug sent me off to collect Seychelles for a while, another time it was Ascension. Other collections have been Offices in Palestine, St. Helena, Nyassa, and a variety of topicals and thematics.

Some of the topicals I have collected are Descendants of Queen Victoria on stamps, Jewish New Year, Buddha, Bridges, Dolls, and Maps. At one time, I had a complete collection of all items connected with World Refugee Year 1960.

Many years ago, when I was president of the Birmingham (AL) Philatelic Society, someone came to talk to us about getting a stamp issued illustrating American dolls. Part of what I did was accumulating a number of world issues on a similar theme.

While working in Hong Kong in 1994, I got interested in their stamps. Rather than try to collect the country, I began collecting topics. I flew into the old airport that was depicted on a number of stamps, the new airport at Chek Lap Kok is served by a cool new bridge that has

been pictured several times. And the world's largest outdoor Buddha statue on the same island at Po Lin Monastery has been shown a number of times.

I also collect Israel as a series of topicals. There are stamps every year for the Jewish New Year; Rosh Hashona. There is also a stamps or five for Independence Day, Memorial Day and various other holidays.

Since I am a calligrapher, I once started a collection in which the central picture had to be ornate letters. There was a shortlived collection of rhinoceri (rhinoceros). I started collecting

computers on stamps before there was such a thing: the key item is the 1964 Israel stamp showing tape reels and a punchcard.






