some people I know that type with one finger.

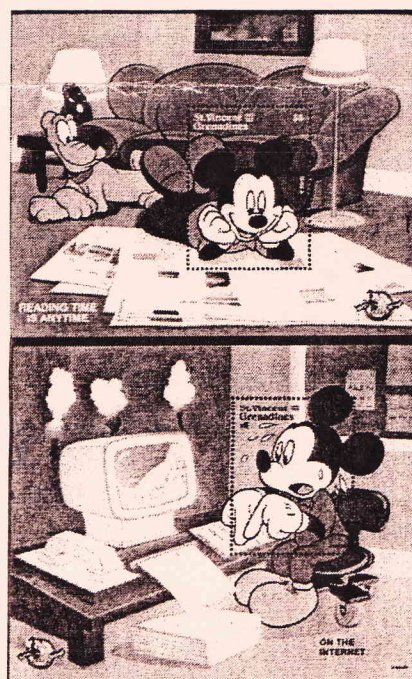
The last computer stamp this
