Did you know?

U.S. Postal Service officials hope that by adopting the four-state bar code as a standard they can reduce the number of bar codes used throughout the postal system.

USPS uses more than 30 bar codes, including:

- Postnet code For sorting mail.
- Planet code For USPS' Confirm service, which tracks individual first-class and standard mail pieces
 through the postal system.
- 2-D code For PC Postage, a USPS-sponsored online service for buying and printing postage.
- Four-state code For existing and future services that provide information about mail sent through the postal system.



An **Auxiliary Marking** is a postal marking applied to covers by handstamp, machine cancellation, a stick-on label, manuscript markings or by mechanical or electronic methods such as addressograph or computer, indicating that the covers were given special attention due to some special circumstances. He had divided his collection into 3 parts.

- 1) Problems caused by the sender
- 2) problems caused by the receiver, and
- 3) problems in between.

Gary's talk, Part I looks at the markings resulting from sender error.




