- Book 5 contains early mint and used coil pairs, few Prexies & Liberties with most after 1975 with many plate number coils. \$129 face after 1950. Noted a few better coil pairs.

When prices change in the future, the Forever Stamp will sell at the new one-ounce, single-piece First-Class Mail price.
